



SOS Children's Villages: A Refuge for Children

With a mission focused on child protection, SOS Children's Villages protects children who have lost, or are at risk of losing, parental care. Its objective is to provide them with an environment of stability and affection in which they can grow and develop integrally. In Spain, more than 50,000 minors are under the Child and Adolescent Protection System, which highlights the need to have spaces that offer containment and security.

The Children's Village of San Lorenzo de El Escorial, founded in 1985, is made up of several homes that take in children from 3 to 17 years old. In these homes, made up mostly of siblings, educators and specialized professionals promote family values and create a protective and reference environment for the children.

Infinorsa and its Commitment to SOS Children's Villages

Since 2022, the Infinorsa collaboration has been key to improving the homes of the SOS Children's Village in San Lorenzo de El Escorial, guaranteeing a safe, welcoming and conducive environment for the development and sense of belonging of the children and young people who live there.

Impact of Collaboration

Thanks to this support, the facilities of the Village have been substantially improved. The comprehensive renovations carried out in the Galicia home (2022) and the Rioja house (2023) continued in 2024 with the rehabilitation of the León house, guaranteeing safe and adequate conditions for the children.

Support for Prevention Programs

In addition to infrastructure improvements, Infinorsa has strengthened the prevention programmes of SOS Children's Villages in Madrid, contributing to the financing of professionals who accompany children and young people in vulnerable situations. With centers such as "El Tomillar", the Family Program, the Nursery School, "Abantos" and "Guadarrama", these teams provide support, education and emotional containment.

Building the Future

The collaboration between Infinorsa and SOS Children's Villages reflects the impact of sustained commitment to children. Thanks to this joint effort, the children of the Children's Village of San Lorenzo de El Escorial can develop in a safe and stable environment, opening the way to a future full of opportunities.





Fundación Infinorsa and Aleph TEA Association: A transformative alliance

Since 2007, the cooperation between Fundación Infinorsa and the Aleph TEA Association has been key in the inclusion and comprehensive development of people with autism in the Community of Madrid.

Both entities share the vision of overcoming the social, cultural and educational barriers that affect people with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). Decisive Funding

From the donation that allowed the construction of the ALEPH School to the contributions destined to the maintenance and expansion of services, Fundación Infinorsa has provided fundamental economic resources. This cooperation has made it possible to create infrastructures and operational continuity with quality innovative programs that make a difference in the care of people with autism.

Strategic Advice

Beyond financial support, the foundation has offered valuable guidance on real estate management and project structuring. Her experience has been crucial in navigating complex processes, from applying and awarding in public tenders (such as the Solidarity Land Network program) to crisis management, ensuring that each initiative was developed in a solid and sustainable way.

Training and Dissemination of Good Practices

The support of Fundación Infinorsa has also made it possible to have resources to promote training programs for staff and the educational community, facilitating the adoption of inclusive and adaptive methodologies.

Fundamental Milestones

Construction of the ALEPH School

The funding provided for the construction of the ALEPH School was decisive for Aleph TEA to have its own and adequate space. This investment made it possible to overcome logistical and economic challenges, laying the foundations for the growth and consolidation of the association.

Expansion of Services

Fundación Infinorsa has supported the commitment to key services, such as the ENCO Project, stable classrooms and the SAICON service, providing resources that have made it possible to strengthen the service and maintain the inclusive approach.

Improvements in Educational and Therapeutic Spaces

The support of Fundación Infinorsa has made it possible to transform the educational environments of Aleph TEA, providing them with cutting-edge resources and highly trained professional teams.

Crisis Response

During the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, Fundación Infinorsa demonstrated its commitment by providing funds to cover extraordinary expenses, such as additional staff and protective equipment, ensuring continuity of care and the safety of beneficiaries. Likewise, its support in the refurbishment of the Day Center at the Guatemala Community Center in 2023 reaffirms its ability to respond quickly and effectively to unforeseen situations.

DEARTE Foundation / Medinaceli DEARTE

The DEARTE Foundation, based in the Ducal Palace of Medinaceli, is a non-profit organisation created in 2005 to promote culture and the repopulation of Soria, one of the most depopulated areas in Europe.

It organizes exhibitions of current art, concerts, film festivals, theater, early music, opera, zarzuela, folk and jazz, as well as the International Lyric Competition "Un Futuro DEARTE". It also promotes cultural and social events that energize the town and the province.

Since 2022, Infinorsa has supported the transformative drive of the DEARTE Foundation in the improvement of its community.



Horta Sud Foundation

With more than 50 years of experience, the Horta Sud Foundation works for the cultural, social and economic development of the region of L'Horta Sud, in the Valencian Community. Founded in 1972 by the Caja General de Ahorros y Monte de Piedad de Torrent as a "Pro-Development Institute", it has evolved to adapt to regulatory and social changes. Its mission is to strengthen the regional identity, promote citizen participation and foster the associative fabric through training, research and community initiatives.

Its board of trustees is made up of key institutions in the region and outstanding people in various fields. Its sphere of action mainly covers L'Horta Sud, although it also carries out activities in other regions of the Valencian Community, Spain and Europe.

Support from Infinorsa

In response to the effects of the catastrophic rains of the DANA in 2024, Fundación Infinorsa collaborated with the Horta Sud Foundation in actions aimed at the recovery and strengthening of the affected community.
